- 5. Establish active chapters throughout Australia for discussion, mutual support and engagement.
- 6. Manage the ISCAST website, Facebook page and Twitter account.
- 7. Seek affiliation with appropriate partner organisations in pursuit of our aims.
- 8. Provide support for Christians who are in or who are entering scientific and theological vocations.
- 9. Promote and conduct public lectures, seminars and courses in science and the Christian faith.
- 10. Cultivate relations with the media to engage in debate in the public arena.
- 11. Produce a biennial conference on science and Christianity (COSAC).
